CALL 332-1472 AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO SCHEDULE YOUR WINTER BOAT HAULING DATE AND TIME.

It is your responsibility as a member of WIBC to have your boat out of the water by October 17.

As it is every year, hauling all of our boats out of the water takes an enormous amount of time and energy. Every year it seems that more and more members wait to the last minute to have their boats hauled. This causes many problems and isn't fair to the members who do the hauling.

All water and electric power will be shut off on the docks October 16. All boats must be out of water by Oct. 17. There is a limit on the number of boats that can be hauled each day. Schedule your hauling date early. If you don't think you are going to use your boat again this fall, get it out of the water, *now*. Don't let your boat just sit in its slip until the last minute. Don't let your batteries die or your bilges may fill with water.

Notice: All docks will be out of the water by Nov. 1. Let the Fleet Captain or another officer know when you want to come out by calling 332-1472. Many boats are pulled during the week. The Club is flexible and will try to work with you to fit your schedule.

Please remember to remove all lines and personal property that are on and around your slip and dock area. WIBC is not responsible for these items.

- WIBC is not responsible for winterizing your boat.
- WIBC encourages owners to be present when their boat is pulled. If you are not present, you'll be charged \$25 for pressure washing.
- Look for your winter storage bill in the mail.
